A Local Law to amend the New York city charter, in relation to establishing a special inspector of labor within the department of investigation

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Section 803 of the New York city charter is amended by adding a new subdivision j to read as follows:

j. The commissioner shall appoint a special inspector of labor who shall coordinate the labor enforcement activities of the department relating to city contracts. If the special inspector of labor determines, based on any investigation made pursuant to subdivision a or b of this section, that any individual or entity that contracts with the city or seeks to contract with the city is or has engaged in violations of labor or employment laws, the special inspector of labor shall make publicly available a statement or report of such findings,

provided that the special inspector of labor shall exercise discretion with respect to the release of information that may affect the integrity of an ongoing investigation or may be subject to confidentiality requirements imposed by law or agreements with other law enforcement agencies.

§ 2. Section 808 of the New York city charter, as added by local law number 43 for the year 2018, is renumbered section 809.

§ 3. This local law takes effect 120 days after it becomes law.
