# Resolution approving the petition for a revocable consent for an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 35-01 Ditmars Boulevard, Queens (20045412 TCQ; L.U. No. 180).

WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on May 7, 2004 its approval of the petition of Tulsace Corp., d/b/a 718, for a revocable consent to establish, maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 35-01 Ditmars Boulevard, Community District 1, Borough of Queens (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");

WHEREAS, the Petition is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 20-226(g) of the Administrative Code;
