A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to requiring a report on voter registration in city jails

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 1 of title 9 of the administrative code is amended by adding a new section 9-161 to

read as follows:

§ 9-161 Voter registration report. a. No later than January 31, 2022 and annually thereafter, the

commissioner shall submit to the mayor, speaker of the council and the public advocate and shall post

conspicuously on the department's website an annual report regarding voter registration in city jails. Such

report shall include the following information for the previous calendar year:

1. The number of events held to promote voter registration and voting;

2. The number of completed voter registration forms returned to the department from incarcerated

individuals, in total and disaggregated by facility and by the race, age, gender, gender identity, sexual orientation, disability status and veteran status of such individual; and

3. The number of absentee ballots the department distributed to incarcerated individuals, in total and disaggregated by facility.

b. The report required by this section must not contain personally identifiable information.

§ 2. This local law takes effect immediately.
