Section 1. Table I of paragraph 5 of subdivision b of section 24-257 of the administrative code of the city of New York, as amended by local law number 80 for the year 2021, is amended to read as follows:

Violations related to section and subdivisionEirst ViolationSecond Violation*Third and Subsequent

the owner, agent, lessee or other person in control of the premises with respect to which the violation occurred, at the same premises (all violations committed within two years).

§ 2. This local law takes effect immediately.
