A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to consumer warnings regarding rifles, shotguns, and firearms

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 3 of title 10 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended by adding

a new section 10-317 to read as follows:

§ 10-317 Consumer warnings regarding weapons and firearms. a. Every dealer in firearms and dealer in rifles and shotguns shall, in the place where rifles, shotguns, or firearms are displayed or where rifles, shotguns, or firearms are transferred to a purchaser, conspicuously post a notice stating: "A firearm in the home significantly increases the risk of suicide, homicide, death during domestic disputes, and unintentional deaths to children, household members, and others. If you or a loved one is experiencing distress or depression, call the Mobile Crisis Team at 1-888-NYC-WELL (1-888-692-9355) or the National Suicide Hotline at 988." Such

signs must be unobstructed in their entirety. Such signs must be at least 8 inches by 11 inches and printed in no

less than 36-point font.

b. Any person who violates subdivision a of this section shall be guilty of a violation punishable by a

fine of not more than \$5,000.

§ 2. This local law takes effect 60 days after it becomes law.
