A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to increasing penalties for violations of requirements that apply to immigration assistance services

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph 2 of subdivision a of section 20-779.1 of the administrative code of the city of New York, as amended by local law number 80 for the year 2020, is amended to read as follows:

(2) Civil Penalties. Any provider of immigration assistance services who violates any provision of this subchapter or any rule or regulation promulgated hereunder shall be liable for a civil penalty of not less than

[five hundred dollars] \$7,500 nor more than [five thousand dollars] \$10,000 for the first violation and for each succeeding violation a civil penalty of not less than [one thousand dollars] \$18,000 nor more than [ten thousand dollars] \$20,000.

§ 2. This local law takes effect immediately.
