A Local Law in relation to a pilot program for increasing the public funds cap

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. a. Notwithstanding paragraph (b) of subdivision 2 of section 3-705 of the administrative

code, for the next special election held pursuant to a proclamation issued after the effective date of this local

law, the principal committee of a participating candidate may receive public funds pursuant to paragraph (a) of

subdivision 2 of section 3-705 of the administrative code in an amount not to exceed eighty-five percent of the

expenditure limitation provided in subdivision one of section 3-706 of the administrative code for the office for

which such candidate seeks election.

b. No later than three months after the special election in subdivision a of this local law, the campaign

finance board shall submit to the mayor and the speaker of the council a report on the distribution of public

funds for such special election, including an analysis of any impact such distribution had on such special

election and a recommendation on whether such a distribution of public funds should be implemented in future

elections.

§ 2. This local law takes effect immediately.
