A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to raising the maximum age to apply to become a firefighter

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph 3 of subdivision a of section 15-103 of the administrative code of the city of New

York is amended to read as follows:

3. Shall have passed his or her [eighteenth] 18th birthday but not his or her [twenty-ninth] 31st birthday

on the date of the filing of his or her application for civil service examination and not his or her 36th birthday

on the date of his or her commencing employment as a firefighter. [No person who qualifies under this

requirement shall be disqualified from membership in the department because of having passed his or her

twenty-ninth_birthday subsequent to the filing of his or her application.] However no person shall be appointed

unless he or she shall have attained his or her [twenty-first] 21st birthday.

§2. This local law takes effect immediately.
